- Contributions to the STATPAC may not exceed \$7,200 per year. Contributions are subject to the prohibitions and limitations of New Jersey election law.

- State law prohibits STATPAC from accepting contributions from banks, insurance companies, public utilities, cable television companies, and any majority
- shareholder in such entities.
- State law (The Casino Control Act NJSA 5:12-138) prohibits STATPAC from accepting contributions from companies that hold or are applicants for a casino license, including any holding company or subsidiary of a casino licensee or applicant. Contributions from officers, directors, and key employees of any such company are prohibited. In addition, contributions by members of the New Jersey Casino Control Commission and its employees are barred.
- It is illegal to reimburse any individual for a contribution to STATPAC. It is illegal to receive a reimbursement for any contribution to STATPAC.

Contributions or gifts to STATPAC, The Political Action Committee of NJ-ACEP are not tax deductible.
